

2015 Busselton Cycling Camp

Saturday 7th to Saturday 21st February 2015 at the Peppermint Park Eco Village

Each year, Club members interested in cycling in and around Busselton meet at the Peppermint Eco Park, Caves Road, Busselton. A variety of accommodation is available at the Park as well as other places close to the Park. Members arrange their own accommodation and decide their own program of events. Rides are conducted daily at 7.30 and 8.00 AM. Most rides are completed by midday, leaving the rest of the day for members to explore the Busselton area. Most of our members camp there between the 7th and 21st of February; however participants can elect to attend for any length of time as a comprehensive ride program and social agenda spans the two weeks.
