



## Notification of use of an Electric Bike on Club rides

Any person intending to use an electric bike (E-bike) on Club rides must complete this form and lodge it with the Ride Captain prior to the e-bike being used on any Club ride.

All E-bikes must comply with European Standard EN 15194 (adopted as AS 15194)

This standard has been adopted by Western Australia.

EN/AS 15194 includes the following requirements:

1. The rider must pedal to activate the motor when travelling at speeds greater than 6km/h.
2. The motor must cut off upon reaching 25 km/hour or when pedalling stops.
3. The maximum continuous power output is not to exceed 250 watts. The motor can produce greater power for a very short period such as pulling away from traffic lights.
4. The motor must be electric.
5. The motor **does not** have a throttle.

If your E-bike (PEDELEC) is compliant with the regulation it will display a label certifying the manufacturer and listing the following:

- A. the manufacturer's name.
- B. the motor's cut off speed in km/h
- C. its electric motor maximum continuous rated power in watts.

**If your E-bike is compliant with the EN 15194 Standard, then sign the declaration below.**
