

Guidelines For Equipment (and Car) Watch Volunteers

- Wear club apparel so you can be identified as supervising the Club equipment and cars
- Arrive 15 minutes before the departure of the early groups
- Maintain oversight of the Club equipment, particularly the public address system
- Make frequent sorties amongst the cars so you are visible to any would be offenders
- Do not physically intervene in situations where anti-social or criminal behaviour is evident, but make a note of any actions that will help in any future investigation
- Call police if you think an incident warrants police intervention
- A list of members' emergency contact phone numbers is stored in the Ride Captain's box if required
- Remain on duty until the first group of riders return to the venue
- Collect ride statistics from Ride Leaders until return of the Ride Captain or Deputy Ride Captain
